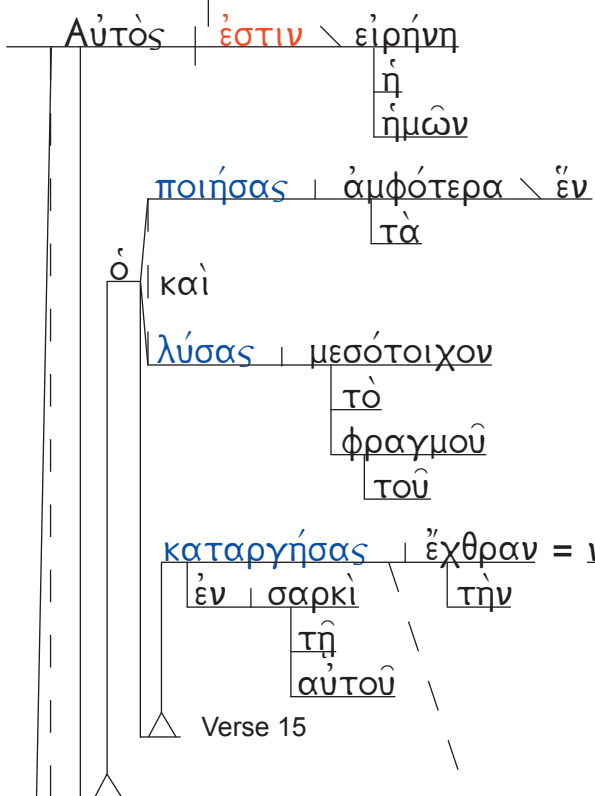


Verse 14 γάρ



There is little doubt because of structure that phrases which are in apposition are to follow one another than to be interrupted by a participle. It is best to regard both the participles λύσας and καταργήσας as occurring at the end of their respective clauses; thus the phrase τὸν νόμον τῶν ἐντολῶν ἐν δόγμασιν is explanatory of the hostility which Christ has abolished in His flesh.
