

Life is ONLY In The Resurrection Part 21

Qualities of Our Resurrected Bodies-2- Imperishable & Immortal Bodies

1 Corinthians 2:14: The man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually discerned.

1 Corinthians 15:22: For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive.

23 But each in his own turn: Christ, the firstfruits; **THEN**, WHEN HE COMES, those who belong to him.

(Col 1:18)

Hebrews 11:35: Women received back their dead, raised to life again. Others were tortured and refused to be released, so that they might gain a better resurrection (*singular-NOT plural*).

John 11:24: Martha answered, "I know he will rise again in the resurrection (*singular-NOT plural*) at the last day."

Luke 14:14: and you will be blessed. Although they cannot repay you, you will be repaid at the resurrection (*singular-NOT plural*) of the righteous."

<p>John 5: 28 New American Standard Bible (NASB) "Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which all (<i>all without distinction-those who belong to Him -1 Cor 15:22</i>) who are <u>in the tombs</u> will hear His voice, 29 and will come forth; those who did the good deeds to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil (bad) deeds to a resurrection of judgment.</p>	<p>Daniel 12:2 (American Standard Version) And MANY of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, AND some to shame and everlasting contempt.</p>

Matthew 7:21: "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.

22 Many (*not just a few then*) will say to me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and in your name drive out demons and perform many miracles?' **23** Then I will tell them plainly, 'I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!'

Luke 6:43: "No good tree bears bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit.

44 Each tree is recognized by its own fruit. People do not pick figs from thorn bushes, or grapes from briars. **45** The good man brings good things out of the good stored up in his heart, and the evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in his heart. For out of the overflow of his heart his mouth speaks.

46 "Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say? **47** I will show you what he is like who comes to me and hears my words and puts them into practice.

Acts 24:14-16: However, I admit that I worship the God of our fathers as a follower of the Way, which they call a sect. I believe everything that agrees with the Law and that is written in the Prophets, **15** and I have the same hope in God as these men, that there will be a resurrection (singular-NOT plural) of both the righteous AND the wicked. *(it's the same resurrection)* **16 So** I strive always to keep my conscience clear before God and man.

"So, So"-- **16 So I strive always** to keep my conscience clear before God and man.

Revelation 20:4: I saw thrones on which were seated those who had been given authority to judge. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony for Jesus and because of the word of God. They had not worshiped the beast or his image and had not received his mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ a thousand years. **5 (The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended.)** This is the first resurrection. **6** Blessed and holy are those **who have part** in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over them, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with him for a thousand years.

John 20:1: Early on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb and saw that the stone had been removed from the entrance. **2** So she came running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved, and said, "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we don't know where they have put him!" **3** So Peter and the other disciple started for the tomb. **4** Both were running, but the other disciple outran Peter and reached the tomb first. **5** He bent over and looked in at the strips of linen lying there but did not go in.

6 Then Simon Peter, who was behind him, arrived and went into the tomb. He saw the strips of linen lying there, **7** as well as the burial cloth that had been around Jesus' head. The cloth was folded up by itself, separate from the linen.

John 20:19: On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" **20** After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord.

1 Corinthians 15:42: So will it be with the resurrection of the dead. The body that is sown is **perishable**, it is raised **imperishable**;
