Present Indicative

*The forms in parentheses are alternative forms because of the movable ν.

Imperfect Indicative

2 nd person	ἦς (ἦσθα)*	you were	ἦτε	you were
3 rd person	ἦν	he/she/it was	ἦσαν	they were
