

**Lesson 13: Pronouns (Module A)**  
**Personal Pronouns**  
**Study Aid Level Two: Read and Translate**

**Instructions:** First, cover the right-hand column with a piece of paper or index card. Read several times the Greek words in the left-hand column. Next, translate into English what you have just read in Greek before uncovering the right-hand column. Finally, check your translation by uncovering the corresponding right-hand column. Words in brackets indicate the English idiom does not require them in translation.
