

Lesson Seven: The Second Declension (Module B)  
 Feminine and Neuter Nouns  
 Level One: Vocabulary Paradigms

As a study aid, most vocabulary words from Lesson Seven are cited below according to paradigm hierarchy in alphabetical order.

Do NOT memorize these paradigms. What is important is to recognize the inflectional forms of the second declension as they relate to case, gender, and number. Study the two master case ending charts below for n-2b (feminine nouns) and n-2c (neuter) nouns. The case endings for n-2b feminine nouns are identical to those of n-2a masculine nouns.
